the persons of the laity are called to share in the dynamism of a christ who seeks his own and the salvation of all people and who calls his disciples to such a sharing, to what extent will christian faith be part of their daily life? the community of the faithful consists of persons who, by exercising the proper meaning of their baptism, seek to follow christ and to grow ever more in love for him through prayer, charity and the observance of the commandments (cf. church teachings, no. 18), since they are the sociological subject of their own faith, lay christians share in the ecclesial mission inasmuch as they put into action in their own lives the whole of the church's mission in all its aspects, in faith, hope and charity, it is for them to share in the apostolic priesthood of christ which, by virtue of the sacrament of baptism, has been conferred on them. so their faithful participation in the new evangelization, which is the church's project for the whole world (cf. church teaching, no. 1), should manifest the awareness of their own personal responsibility before god, which is required of them for a life of faith (church teaching, no. 17), the people of god are called to become witnesses of christ in the world. they are confronted with the condition of the world and of their own role in history, and they are called to appropriate the gift of their baptismal vocation for the salvation of all. all ministries are oriented to the spread of the word and the good news, drawing near to christ's people with confidence, love and dedication. in the community of the faithful, all persons are called to share in the word's proclamation and to belong to a christian people in communion with the church and with one another in all its hierarchical organizations, they are called to recognize their responsibility as members of a family of the gospel and to enjoy the fruits of the new life in christ that is theirs through faith. the newness of the gospel demands that the church be open to being evangelized herself, to being refreshed in the renewal of her life in the spirit of her master, the lay faithful, who are the church's agents and its members, should participate in this renewal in the spirit of joy and hope, while being concerned for the world in its need and vulnerability, each of them must be attentive to being his or her own true evangelizer, they are to manifest their joy in experiencing the love that unites them in communion with god and each other, in their participation in the good news of salvation, in their worship of the living god in a language that is accessible to all those who listen, and in a proclamation of the gospel of reconciliation to the whole of the human family.

a second moment in the interpretation of culture is that of the present. here the church offers in prevision a sign of the life to come. it relates, at the same time, to the past, the canonical past of the church, but also to the future, since it gives a glimpse of the life of christ and his church, this prevision is expressed in the church's word and sacrament, the church's present mission, then, is made up of two levels: the direct mission is that of sharing the grace of jesus with all men, through the

mediation of the word and sacrament, in what the apostle paul called a renewed and living way[1118]. canada does not need to embark on a social policy of revolution, as some in the past did in the name of progress. indeed, it is important that there be a dialogue among canadians on the problems of social justice today, so that they can be faced in an open and honest manner, so that everyone can seek the response that best suits their concrete situation, 300, first-ofall, in order to achieve a true understanding of social problems, we must ask who the social actors

are in all the activities and structures of society. we must find out the true nature of the various interests that are represented in the social system. this is an essential step in discerning and determining what the various interests want from society in the first place and what response society can give to their demands, and in keeping with what is good and just. through the social analysis that follows, a social evaluation takes place, whereby it is established what society's social needs and obligations are. it is necessary to recognize that, at present, the

interests that are furthered and that have predominance are the interests of a new society, of society "after" socialism, i.e. of a capitalist society with a globalized economy, decentralized administration, the predominance of large and powerful multinational companies and the continual push for efficiency and competition. this is the new social order and organization of society that must be changed and adapted to the requirements of a different kind of society. from this standpoint, it is also clear that the interests of the working class, although they do constitute the

majority of the working population, are not the interests that actually determine the daily concerns of the social body. the majority of canadians themselves contribute to the accumulation of riches, and to the progress of technology and scientific knowledge that are the main instruments for accumulating wealth. the working class participates less in this process than it did in the past, and thus less feels the desire for material benefits and the sense of being exploited that used to provide the incentive to work and fight for social justice and harmony, on

the contrary, citizens of this new society feel that all social progress is that which facilitates and reinforces their freedom, their detachment from the more pedestrian worries of everyday life, and even their need to seek satisfaction and escape from the pressure of labour and work. the demands that are sensed most strongly by the working class today are those which are in line with their personal desire for selffulfilment through their work and with what is important to them, i. independence, the right to leisure, the value of their own culture, security in old age, the

usefulness of their skills and abilities, the autonomy of personal decisions, the right to family life, the opportunity to transmit the proper values and ideals of their work to their children, to their community, and to the entire human race, the effectiveness of the interests represented by the working class is a basic condition for any change in the social order, for any improvement in the conditions of work and for the full realization of the fundamental social rights of workers. 5ec8ef588b
